A dream location






Just a few steps from the historic center, the Grand Hôtel du Soleil d'Or enjoys a privileged location, perfectly balanced between village authenticity and direct access to the mountains. Its elevated position offers sweeping panoramic views, while its deep roots in local heritage make it a haven of choice for travelers seeking breathtaking and inspiring landscapes.

Surrounding the hotel, Megève reveals all its charm: cobbled streets, century-old chalets, art galleries, exclusive boutiques, and its iconic, fully restored bell tower. Just a short stroll away lies the village square, ski lifts leading to the slopes, and forest trails perfect for walking, snowshoeing, or cycling. In both winter and summer, nature is right at your fingertips, and the pleasures of the mountains can be enjoyed effortlessly.

Living memory of Megève



The Grand Hôtel du Soleil d'Or is one of Megève's very first hotels. Opened in 1901, long before the resort became a symbol of Alpine luxury, it witnessed the birth of this now world-renowned mountain destination.



When the Rothschild family chose Megève in the 1920s to create an elegant alternative to Saint-Moritz, they helped transform the village into a chic and exclusive resort. The Soleil d'Or then became one of the premier addresses for hosting high society travelers eager to experience the pleasures of snow, mountains, and what was already French excellence. A witness to this formative era, the establishment has endured through the decades while preserving its pioneering spirit.

The revival of an iconic hotel

Reimagined in 2019 by Marie-Christine Mecoen, the hotel retains the soul of the old house while embracing contemporary codes of wellness, taste, and Alpine refinement.

"Here, we wanted to offer a complete sensory experience. The mountains, yes, but with that extra touch of soul, that taste of childhood rediscovered over a hot chocolate or in the calm of an intimate spa," sums up the architect of this five-star masterpiece.

Three sources of inspiration guided the rebirth of the Grand Hôtel du Soleil d'Or: wood, a raw and noble material uncovered beneath the original carpeting; chocolate, a sensory and emotional thread; and finally, the thermal history of Megève, once called Mag Eva — "the town between the waters."





The soul of the rooms and chalets



At the Grand Hôtel du Soleil d'Or, each room has been designed as a cocoon of comfort and elegance. Up to the third floor, the rooms are called "Carrés," a delicious nod to the world of chocolate, the hotel's signature theme and a beloved highlight for many guests. On the top floor, Nature takes over: the rooms there celebrate the vast open spaces and landscapes visible from the heights of Megève.

Light wood, cozy alcoves, large mirrors reflecting winter landscapes, themed photographs, wools from the Alps and the Pyrenees, velvet curtains... Everything is designed to recreate the intimacy of a mountain retreat. The spacious bathrooms, featuring bathtubs overlooking the view, invite relaxation just like in a private spa.







Hidden from view, the three chalets of the Grand Hôtel du Soleil d'Or embody the art of the Alpine retreat with distinctive personality. Spacious (225 sqm) and welcoming, each tells a story—a memory of Megève—drawn from the mountain pioneers, the legend of ski champions, and the recollection of the very first red gondola leading to the peaks.

The spa, a sanctuary of well-being



In perfect harmony with Megève's thermal heritage, the Grand Hôtel Soleil d'Or spa is a haven of relaxation. Redesigned around natural elements stone, water, and greenery — it offers a soothing and sensorv retreat in an intimate setting, accessible reservation only.

Heated indoor pool set in a décor inspired by Alpine landscapes, sauna, steam room, jacuzzi: every facility is designed to promote relaxation and rejuvenate both body and mind. The signature Mineral-Chocolate treatment, exclusive to the hotel, combines the benefits of chocolate and trace elements for a sensory journey that is both energizing and enveloping.

The menu also offers a collection of indulgent and refined rituals — scrubs, massages, facial and body treatments, enriched with delicious textures featuring almond, chocolate, or semiprecious stones.

With its cozy atmosphere, mineral and botanical design, exceptional treatments, and comprehensive facilities, the spa promises a unique and deeply rejuvenating experience.



Three tables, three flavors




La Fromagerie, alpine cuisine

Located on the ground floor, La Fromagerie is a temple dedicated to cheese, celebrating Savoyard and Swiss specialties.
